

## Service Project Continuum:

### EXAMPLE ISSUE:

Litter, dirty streets and parks

<p><b>Service</b> Monitor recycling bin at the cafeteria during lunch for one half hour</p> <p><b>Learning</b> Read a book about where trash goes when it is picked up</p>	<p><b>Service</b> Pick up trash in the park for one hour</p> <p><b>Learning</b> Research the effects of litter on the community</p>	<p><b>Service</b> Volunteer at a recycling center for one hour a week</p> <p><b>Learning</b> Write a report about the importance of recycling and send it to a government official</p>	<p><b>Service</b> Organize a school Earth Day</p> <p><b>Learning</b> Make information booths for the day about different environmental issues</p>	<p><b>Service</b> Plan, build and maintain a community garden</p> <p><b>Learning</b> Decide what to plant based on scientific experimentation on plants and their responses to light</p>

### EXAMPLE ISSUE:

Hunger

<p><b>Service</b> Stuff envelopes dropped off by a food pantry representative for one half hour</p> <p><b>Learning</b> Read a book about hunger</p>	<p><b>Service</b> Volunteer at a food pantry for an hour</p> <p><b>Learning</b> Make presentations in every classroom or organize an assembly about hunger</p>	<p><b>Service</b> Go door to door to collect items needed by the food pantry</p> <p><b>Learning</b> Write a letter to neighbors explaining how they can help fight hunger</p>	<p><b>Service</b> Organize a school food drive</p> <p><b>Learning</b> Make presentations in every classroom or organize an assembly about hunger</p>	<p><b>Service</b> Plan &amp; host an annual <i>Share Your Lunch</i> event to raise money and cans for the food pantry</p> <p><b>Learning</b> Have students write and perform a play for the community about how people can help fight hunger</p>
